MISSION STATEMENT**

We are charged with providing financial assistance over the next twenty years, by use of a 20-year Term Fund, to the teachers and staff in the Upper Arlington School system for the benefit of the students from grades K through 12. The funds we raise will be administered through the Upper Arlington Education Foundation.

What is a 20-year Term Fund? It means that the UAEF must spend all the funds raised by the class over the next twenty years. We chose this option, so we could see the effects of our efforts, while most of us are still alive to appreciate it.

The Core project we decided to support is Service Learning, since that program is losing both Federal and State funding at the end of the 2012 academic year. However, gifts from our classmates can be designated by them to support any other program under the control of the UA Educational Foundation.

Funds will be raised through a campaign seeking voluntary donations from our classmates both before the reunion and as a follow up after the reunion. We are asking everyone to consider a five-year pledge in order to maximize the amount of the gift and to make it easier to pay smaller amounts over a longer period of time. Also a one-time gift would be equally appreciated for those who choose that option.
